

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Courts Legislation Amendment (Broadcasting Judgments) Act 2014*. These provisions amend the *District Court Act 1973* to require the District Court to permit the recording and broadcast of certain judgments given by the Court in open court unless satisfied that one of a limited number of exclusionary grounds is present.
