#### **Explanatory note**

The objects of this Regulation are as follows:

- (a) to increase certain fees payable in relation to civil proceedings generally or in relation to the functions exercised by the Sheriff,
- (b) to introduce a tiered fee structure for the filing of originating processes in Class 8 of the Land and Environment Court's jurisdiction, being mining matters.
- (c) to introduce new daily hearing fees for matters in the District Court civil proceedings list,

This Regulation is made under the Civil Procedure Act 2005, including section 18 (Fees).

#### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Civil Procedure Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2015.

#### 2 Commencement
