Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to update the list of diseases affecting fish and marine vegetation set out in Schedule 6B to the *Fisheries Management Act 1994*, and
- (b) to update the list of noxious fish and marine vegetation set out in Schedule 6C to that Act, and
- (c) to ensure that common and scientific names for species of fish referred to in Schedules 1B, 1C and 6B are consistent with the Australian Standard, and
- (d) to make a consequential amendment.

This Regulation is made under the *Fisheries Management Act 1994*, including sections 182, 209A and 289 (the general regulation-making power).
