

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence an amendment to the *Ports and Maritime Administration Act 1995* to enable regulations to be made to prohibit or regulate the occupation of navigable waters by vessels, floating objects or structures (including the use of moorings in any waters).
