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1 Name of Order

This Order is the Administrative Arrangements (Administration of Acts—Amendment No 4) Order 2015.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Allocation of the administration of Acts

- (1) The administration of the Acts listed in Schedule 1 are allocated to the Ministers indicated in that Schedule.
- (2) The administration of Acts or parts of Acts that directly amend other Acts are allocated to the Ministers administering the Act amended.
- (3) The allocations made by this Order replace any previous allocations relating to the Acts concerned.

Note. See section 15 of the *Interpretation Act 1987* for the interpretation of references to "the Minister" in an Act.

4 Consequential provision

A reference in the *Fair Trading Act 1987* to any other Act or legislation administered by the Minister (being an Act or legislation other than the *Fair Trading Act 1987*) is taken not to include any of the Acts allocated by this Order to the Minister for Innovation and Better Regulation.
