

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Court Security Amendment Act 2011*. These provisions amend the *Court Security Act 2005* to extend the powers of arrest of court security officers to persons who are committing, or who have just committed, acts of violence towards other persons in court premises.
