

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the Workers Compensation Act 1987 that relate to:

- (a) the minimum weekly amount of compensation payable in respect of a worker with highest needs, and
- (b) the removal of an eligibility test for weekly payments of compensation requiring a worker to work a minimum number of hours and earn a minimum amount, and
- (c) the stay of a work capacity decision, and
- (d) the removal of certain limitations on the payment of compensation for medical and related expenses.
