

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence most of the amendments made by the *Mining and Petroleum Legislation Amendment (Grant of Coal and Petroleum Prospecting Titles) Act 2015.* The only amendment that will remain uncommenced is an amendment to the *Mining Act 1992* that provides that land that forms part of a controlled release area cannot be constituted as, or added to, an opal prospecting area.
