
Local Government Amendment (Governance and Planning) Act 2016 No 38

THOMAS FREDERICK BATHURST, Lieutenant-Governor

I, the Honourable Thomas Frederick Bathurst AC, Lieutenant-Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 (1) of the *Local Government Amendment (Governance and Planning) Act 2016*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint:

- (a) 23 September 2016 as the day on which Schedule 1 [1]–[3], [5], [7], [9], [10], [13], [15], [16], [23], [24], [32], [33], [39], [46]–[49] and [80]–[83] commence, and
- (b) 1 October 2016 as the day on which Schedule 1 [36]–[38] commence.

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Local Government Act 1993* relating to the following matters:

- (a) the purpose of the Act and principles for local government,
- (b) the roles of governing bodies of councils, mayors and councillors,
- (c) the appointment of administrators, financial controllers and temporary advisers,
- (d) the functions of general managers,
- (e) delegations by councils,
- (f) the auditing of councils by the Auditor-General.
