

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence all the provisions of the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Amendment (Container Deposit Scheme) Act 2016* other than provisions relating to:

- (a) the regulation of the supply of beverage containers, and
- (b) the entitlement to the payment of refund amounts for the collection of beverage containers at collection points.
