Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to omit the corporate name of an electricity generator (Delta Electricity) from Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the *Energy Services Corporations Act 1995*. On the day on which this Proclamation takes effect that electricity generator is dissolved (see clause 3 (2) of Schedule 6 to the *Electricity Generator Assets (Authorised Transactions) Act 2012*).
