

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence section 44BF of the Workers Compensation Act 1987, which:

- (a) provides that a legal practitioner is not entitled to legal costs in connection with a review in certain circumstances, and
- (b) allows the regulations to make provision for costs orders in certain circumstances in relation to a review.
