Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to clarify that a child who is more than 6 years old must be supervised during the child's employment by a parent or the parent's nominee or by an adult with both training and experience in the care of children of the age of the child to be supervised.

This Regulation is made under the *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998*, including section 264 (the general regulation-making power).
