# **Electricity (Consumer Safety) Amendment Regulation 2017**

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to enable the Secretary to delegate his or her functions under the *Electricity (Consumer Safety) Act 2004* or regulations under that Act to persons to whom electricity network assets have been transferred under Part 2 of the *Electricity Network Assets (Authorised Transactions) Act 2015* or any person engaged or employed by such a person.

This Regulation is made under the *Electricity (Consumer Safety) Act 2004*, including sections 54 and 55 (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Electricity (Consumer Safety) Amendment Regulation 2017*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Amendment of Electricity (Consumer Safety) Regulation 2015**

#### **Clause 44**

Insert after clause 43:

#### **44 Delegated functions**

For the purposes of paragraph (c) of the definition of *authorised person* in section 54 (4) of the Act, any person to whom electricity network assets have been transferred under Part 2 of the *Electricity Network Assets (Authorised Transactions) Act 2015*, and a person employed or engaged by any such person, are prescribed.
