Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Liquor and Gaming Legislation Amendment Act 2018*, which contain amendments to:

- (a) the *Betting and Racing Act 1998* and the *Betting and Racing Regulation 2012* relating to:
 - (i) gambling advertising and inducements, and
 - (ii) the personal executive liability of directors and other corporate officers as a consequence of corporate offences under that Act, and
- (b) the *Totalizator Act 1997* and the *Totalizator Regulation 2012* to strengthen provisions prohibiting the offering of inducements to gamble and certain forms of gambling advertisements and totalizator advertisements.
