Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Civil Procedure Regulation 2017* to generally increase the fees payable in relation to civil proceedings and the fees payable in relation to the functions exercised by the Sheriff. Certain fees payable in connection with the provision of access to documents are not increased.

This Regulation is made under the Civil Procedure Act 2005, including section 18 (Fees).
