# **Industrial Relations (General) Amendment (Fees) Regulation 2018**

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Industrial Relations (General) Regulation 2015* with respect to certain fees charged in relation to proceedings in the Industrial Relations Commission, in alignment with fees charged for similar matters in the Supreme Court, Land and Environment Court, District Court and Local Court.

This Regulation is made under the *Industrial Relations Act 1996*, including sections 183 and 407 (the general regulation-making power).
