Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase the number of demerit points incurred for offences relating to the use of mobile phones.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport Act 2013*, including sections 23 (the general statutory rule-making power) and 32.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Amendment (Demerit Points) Regulation 2018*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 17 September 2018 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2017

(1) Schedule 1 National schedule of demerit point offences

Omit “4” and “8” from Columns 3 and 4, respectively, in the matter relating to rule 300 of the *Road Rules 2014*.

Insert instead “5” and “10”.

(2) Schedule 2 Additional demerit point offences

Omit “4” and “8” from Columns 3 and 4, respectively, in the matter relating to rule 300–1 of the *Road Rules 2014*.
