
Victims Rights and Support Amendment (Statutory Review) Act 2018 No 34

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Victims Rights and Support Act 2013* and other legislation, except a provision that authorises the registrar of a court that has given a direction for compensation to provide the offender's name and address to the victim, as that provision commenced on 1 December 2018.
