Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to allow Roads and Maritime Services to exempt any class of persons or vessels from the provisions of the *Marine Safety Regulation 2016* by publishing an order in the Gazette instead of on the NSW legislation website, as is currently the case.

This Regulation is made under the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, including sections 137 (the general regulation-making power) and 139.
