

Forestry Amendment (Transitional Arrangements) Regulation 2019

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Forestry Act 2012*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to extend, until 9 November 2020, the transitional arrangements under clause 17A of Schedule 3 to the *Forestry Act 2012* relating to bee-keeping and grazing carried out in accordance with the provisions of an integrated forestry operations approval in force immediately before 9 November 2018. On 9 November 2018, bee-keeping and grazing ceased to be matters for which an integrated forestry operations approval may provide.

This Regulation is made under the *Forestry Act 2012*, including section 92 (the general regulation-making power) and clause 1 of Schedule 3.
