1 Name of Order

This Order is the Administrative Arrangements (Administration of Acts—Amendment No 1) Order 2020.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Allocation of the administration of Acts

- (1) The administration of the Acts listed in Schedule 1 are allocated to the Ministers specified in that Schedule.
- The allocations made by this Order replace any previous allocations relating to the Acts concerned that are inconsistent with the allocations made by this Order.

Schedule 1 Allocation of the administration of Acts

DEPUTY PREMIER, MINISTER FOR REGIONAL NEW SOUTH WALES, INDUSTRY AND TRADE

Community Welfare Act 1987 No 52, Part 5 and any other provisions of that Act in so far as they relate to functions under Part 5, jointly with the Minister for Police and Emergency Services

State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989 No 165, in so far as it relates to emergency recovery, jointly with the Minister for Police and Emergency Services

MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES

Community Welfare Act 1987 No 52, Part 5 and any other provisions of that Act in so far as they relate to functions under Part 5, jointly with the Deputy Premier, Minister for Regional New South Wales, Industry and Trade

State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989 No 165 (except parts, jointly with the Deputy Premier, Minister for Regional New South Wales, Industry and Trade)

MINISTER FOR FAMILIES, COMMUNITIES AND DISABILITY SERVICES

Community Welfare Act 1987 No 52 (except parts, the Deputy Premier, Minister for Regional New South Wales, Industry and Trade and the Minister for Police and Emergency Services, jointly)
