

# Photo Card Amendment (Penalty Notice Offences) Regulation 2020

Photo Card Act 2005

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Photo Card Act 2005*.

#### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to increase the penalties for offences dealt with by way of a penalty notice issued under the *Photo Card Act 2005*. The increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index.

This Regulation is made under the *Photo Card Act 2005*, including sections 34 and 36 (the general regulation-making power).

#### 1 Name of Regulation

### Schedule 1 Penalty notice offences

#### 1 Application of Schedule

- (1) For the purposes of section 34 of the Act—
  - (a) each offence created by a provision specified in this Schedule is an offence for which a penalty notice may be issued, and
  - (b) the amount payable for the penalty notice is the amount specified opposite the provision.
- (2) If the provision is qualified by words that restrict its operation to limited kinds of offences or to offences committed in limited circumstances, the penalty notice may be issued only for—
  - (a) that limited kind of offence, or
  - (b) an offence committed in those limited circumstances.
