Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to postpone the date on which special statutory provisions enacted in response to the COVID-19 pandemic are repealed.

This Regulation is made under the *Interpretation Act 1987*, including section 90.

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely matters of a machinery nature and matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on any sector of the public.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Interpretation (COVID-19) Regulation 2020*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definition

In this Regulation—

the Act means the *Interpretation Act 1987*.

4 COVID-19 pandemic—repeal of special provisions

Part 12 of the Act is repealed on 31 December 2020.

5 Repeal

This Regulation is repealed on 1 January 2021.
