1 Name of Rule

Schedule 1 Amendment of Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005

[1] Rule 3.10 Request for a certified copy of a judgment or order

Insert “, or a certified copy of the reasons for the judgment or order,” after “judgment or order” in rule 3.10(1).

[2] Rule 3.10(3)

Insert “or order, or a certified copy of the reasons” after “judgment”.

[3] Rule 36.12 Registrar to furnish copies of judgments and other documents

Insert after rule 36.12(1)(a)—

- (a1) furnish a certified copy of any reasons for a judgment or order given or made in proceedings to any person who applies for such a copy, or

[4] Rule 36.12(1)(b) and (1A)

Insert “, or the reasons for the judgment or order” after “order” wherever occurring.

[5] Rule 50.14 Reasons for decision, transcript and other parts of the record of the court below

Insert “sealed copy of the order and a certified” before “copy of the reasons” in rule 50.14(1)(a).

[6] Rule 51.27 Contents of Red Book

Insert “a certified copy of” before “the reasons for judgment” in rule 51.27(1)(d).
