Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to declare *Murray Valley Wine Grape Industry Development* (Extraterritorial) Order 2020 of Victoria to be a recognised foundation instrument for the purposes of the Agricultural Industry Services Act 1998.

This Regulation is made under the *Agricultural Industry Services Act 1998*, including sections 32D and 51 (the general regulation-making power).
