Paintball Amendment Regulation 2020

under the

Paintball Act 2018

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Paintball Act 2018*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Paintball Regulation 2019* to—

- (a) allow the holder of a paintball venue permit to supply a paintball marker to the holder of a paintball marker permit at an authorised paintball venue, and
- (b) remove a requirement so the holder of a paintball venue permit who does not supervise the use of paintball markers at a paintball venue may be considered a suitable person to hold the permit without the need to undertake a training course in paintball marker safety.

This Regulation is made under the *Paintball Act 2018*, including sections 11(1)(e), 14(1)(e) and 80 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Paintball Amendment Regulation 2020*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Paintball Regulation 2019

(1) Clause 3A

Insert before clause 4—

3A Supply of paintball markers at authorised paintball venue

For the purposes of section 11(1)(e) of the Act, the Secretary may authorise the holder of a paintball venue permit to supply a paintball marker to the holder of a paintball marker permit at an authorised paintball venue.

(2) Clause 4 Training

Omit “permit (other than an international paintball competitor permit)”.

Insert instead “paintball marker permit”.
