Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to declare the Environment Protection Authority to be the appropriate regulatory authority for non-scheduled activities carried on at certain premises at Kooragang Island.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Protection of the Environment Operations (General)* Amendment (Kooragang Island Premises) Regulation 2021.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Protection of the Environment Operations (General) Regulation 2021 Clause 120A

Insert after clause 120—

120A Kooragang Island premises

- (1) The EPA is declared, under the Act, section 6(3), to be the appropriate regulatory authority for non-scheduled activities carried on at the Kooragang Island premises.
- (2) In this clause—

Kooragang Island premises means the premises shown in yellow on the map entitled "Surrender Notice 1111840" and published on the EPA's website on 26 October 2021.
