Explanatory note

The object of this order is to remove COVID-19, also known as Novel Coronavirus 2019, from the following lists under the *Public Health Act 2010*—

- (a) Category 2 medical conditions,
- (b) Category 4 medical conditions,
- (c) contact order conditions.

COVID-19 will remain a Category 3 medical condition.

1 Name of order

This order is the *Public Health Amendment (Scheduled Medical Conditions and Notifiable Diseases) Order 2023*.

2 Commencement

This order commences on 1 September 2023.

3 Amendment of Public Health Act 2010 No 127

(1) Schedule 1 Scheduled medical conditions

Omit “COVID-19 (also known as Novel Coronavirus 2019)” from the matter under the heading “Category 2”.

(2) Schedule 1, matter under the heading “Category 4”

Omit “COVID-19 (also known as Novel Coronavirus 2019)”.

(3) Schedule 1A Contact order conditions

Omit the matter relating to COVID-19 (also known as Novel Coronavirus 2019).
