1 Name of regulation

Schedule 1 Amendment of Liquor Regulation 2018

Clause 132B

Insert after clause 132A—

132B Outdoor dining and performances

Despite the Act, section 167, the Act, Part 12—

- (a) is taken not to have been repealed, and
- (b) is taken to have been amended in accordance with the 24-Hour Economy Legislation Amendment (Vibrancy Reforms) Act 2023, Schedule 2[63]–[69], and
- (c) is taken to continue in force, as amended, until the repeal of this clause.
