Citation

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Regulation 1993.

Commencement

2. This Regulation commences on 1 July 1993

Certificates of authority

- **3.** For the purposes of section 50 (2) (f) of the Noxious Weeds Act 1993, the officer whose signature is required on a certificate of authority is:
 - (a) if the local control authority that issues the certificate is a council or a county council, the general manager of the council or county council; or
 - (b) if the local control authority that issues the certificate is the Western Lands Commissioner, the Western Lands Commissioner.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 50 of the Noxious Weeds Act 1993 provides that a person authorised under the Act to enter premises, or exercise certain powers in or about any premises. may not exercise such powers unless the person possesses, and produces on request, a certificate of authority (issued by the relevant local control authority and containing specified details).

Section 50 (2) (f) requires the certificate of authority to contain the signature of an officer prescribed by the regulations for that purpose. The object of this Regulation is to prescribe such officers.
